SUPPORT





Why partner with the Brain Aneurysm Foundation?



It is estimated that up to 1 in 50 people in the U.S. will develop a brain aneurysm during their lifetime.



Ruptured brain aneurysms are fatal in about **50% of cases.** Of those who survive, about 66% suffer some permanent neurological deficit.



The federal government spends only **\$2.94 per year** on brain aneurysm research for each person afflicted.

Brain aneurysms are treatable, which is why identifying an aneurysm before rupture is critical. With research and appropriate scanning, we can all get a step closer to preventing ruptures, disability, and death.
