This is personal to me. As some of you may know, I suffered a brain aneurysm rupture on November 27, 2023. I am incredibly blessed that I am alive, and I can tell my story in the hopes of saving another. My father was not so lucky and is part of the 50% of people who suffer a fatal rupture. If people were made aware of the signs, symptoms, and the hereditary link between brain aneurysms, lives could be saved.

Brain aneurysms are called silent killers as they sometimes present with no symptoms or are ignored or misdiagnosed. It is estimated that 1 in 50 people in the world have an unruptured brain aneurysm, and a rupture occurs every 18 minutes. When I hear these numbers, I realize how lucky I truly am.

SUPPORT



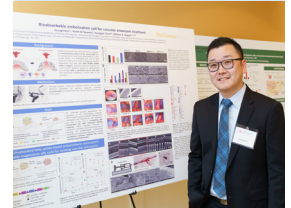
